- ▶ share intelligence and information that helps engaging in key debates
- ▶ mobilize around specific topic and take joint actions
- ▶ explore new ideas and projects
- ▶ connect, exchange and network with other partners and stakeholders

EuroNGOs members receive a wide range of benefits and discounts, many of which are highlighted below:

- participate in the governance of the network, elect the Steering Committee, provide representatives to serve on the Steering Committee, and change the governing instruments of the network;
- make use of EuroNGOs Secretariat for matters of interest and benefit to EuroNGOs members as a whole.
- participate in the Annual General Meeting (AGM);
- shape the development of EuroNGOs vision and strategy;
- be represented in international advocacy arenas, and have the opportunity to represent the network;
- shape the development of EuroNGOs policy positions and advocacy activities;
- convene a task group to implement specific EuroNGOs activities/projects;
- participate in, or organise, EuroNGOs learning and training activities including strategy meeting and workshops;
